


Armstrong School District Factsheet 2023

What does this mean for the Armstrong School District?




Armstrong rank in current spending out of 500 school districts (#1 being the highest).

HERE IS WHAT HAS CHANGED FOR THE DISTRICT SINCE 2011 WHEN THE STATE DRAMATICALLY REDUCED EDUCATION FUNDING:

+ \$4,107,395 + 7.4179% Increase in instructional costs for the district		+ \$2,083,278 + 6% Change in state funding to cover instructional costs	
+ 45% + \$5,112,409	Change in expenditures for special education		
+ 23% +\$932,115	Change in state revenue dedicated to special education		
+ 137% + \$1,979,241	Change in payments to charter schools
