


William Penn School District Factsheet 2023

What does this mean for the William Penn School District?




William Penn rank in current spending out of 500 school districts (#1 being the highest).

HERE IS WHAT HAS CHANGED FOR THE DISTRICT SINCE 2011 WHEN THE STATE DRAMATICALLY REDUCED EDUCATION FUNDING:

+ \$13,689,275 + 25% Increase in instructional costs for the district		+ \$3,477,051 + 12% Change in state funding to cover instructional costs
+ 66% + \$9,836,138	Change in expenditures for special education	
+ 30% +\$1,176,296	Change in state revenue dedicated to special education	
+ 197% + \$9,436,764	Change in payments to charter schools
