


Pennsylvania is not paying its fair share for public schools. It ranks 45<sup>th</sup> in the country in state share of education costs.

HERE IS WHAT HAS CHANGED FOR THE DISTRICT SINCE 2011 WHEN THE STATE DRAMATICALLY REDUCED EDUCATION FUNDING:

+ \$62,165,286 + 45% Increase in instructional costs for the district		+ \$1,229,214 + 19% Change in state funding to cover instructional costs
<b>+ 54%</b> + \$17,365,232.52	Change in expenditures for special education	
<b>+ 9%</b> +\$271,264	Change in state revenue dedicated to special education	
+ 675% + \$2,453,513	Change in payments to charter schools
